RE: CONTINUATION OF THE SEPTEMBER - DECEMBER 2017 SEMESTER

Following the special University Senate Board meeting that was held on **22nd December, 2017**, it was resolved that the semester under reference be re-opened for continuation on **2nd January, 2018** after the Christmas break. We would therefore, wish to release the following information to you:-

- i) Welcome to the New Year, 2018. We are wishing you a fruitful and prosperous New Year.
- ii) Lectures are scheduled to start immediately. We are using the timetable that was released at the beginning of the semester in September, 2017. However, lecturers may create extra time to fast-track syllabus coverage.
- iii) Note that the semester schedule was revised to end on **9th February, 2018** in order to cover up for the teaching time that was lost during the lecturers' strike.
- iv) Those with fee balances are expected to clear by **5th January, 2018**. Kindly note that students with fee balances will not be allowed to sit for end of semester exams.
- v) Examinations for Diploma/Certificate courses will be done from **29th January to 2nd February 2018**. Degree courses examinations will commence on **5th February** and end on **9th February, 2018**.
