DEADLINE EXTENSION FOR RECEIVING APPLICATIONS FOR CO-OPERATIVE BANK FOUNDATION SPONSORSHIP

This is to notify you that Co-operative Bank Foundation offers scholarships to two (2) very needy students annually. We wish to inform prospective applicants that the deadline for receiving the applications has been extended to **Wednesday 10th April 2019**.

Applicants should meet the following requirements:

1. Must be studying Diploma in Co-operative Management;
2. Must be belonging to September 2018 or January 2019 cohort;
3. Must be a full-time student;
4. Must not have been involved in any disciplinary case;
5. Parent/Guardian must be a member of a Co-operative Society or been involved in any Co-operative related activities. This will be an added advantage;
6. Must be a needy student based on:
 - High accumulated fee balances;
 - Confirmed inability to raise fees through referees e.g. local chief, former school head or church leader;
 - Low income of parents/guardians
 - Evidence of being orphaned;
 - Any other relevant socio-economic background disadvantage

Application Procedure

Applicants shall fill prescribed application forms from the Dean of Students Office that detail their bio-data, parents/guardian ability to pay fees, fee balances and justification of the need.
