- 1. Fees are paid through: Any branch of the Co-operative Bank of Kenya, Account Number 01129062663600, Karen branch, M-Pesa paybill Number 400222, Account number 723#admission number. The university will not accept cash payment and personal cheques.
- Accommodation is not guaranteed by the university. The fee payable is Kshs.12, 000/= per semester. This must be paid in the bank by students who may be accommodated. There are limited accommodation facilities that will be offered on first come first served basis.
- Fees once paid are NOT refundable or transferable.
