#### IMPORTANT NOTES

- Fees are paid through: Any branch of the Co-operative Bank of Kenya, Account Number 01129062663600, Karen branch, M-Pesa paybill Number 400222, Account number 723#admission number. The university will not accept cash payment and personal cheques.
- Accommodation is not guaranteed by the university. The fee payable is Kshs.12, 000/= per semester. This must be paid in the bank by students who may be accommodated. There are limited accommodation facilities that will be offered on first come first served basis.
- Fees once paid are NOT refundable or transferable.
- Fees payment plan; full fees payment on registration day or in two installments, 50% of the fees on registration day and the balance of 50% by the 6<sup>th</sup> week of the semester.
- Graduation fee, gown and alumni fee are payable before graduation and is therefore not included in the fee structure
- Attachment fees will be paid by students required to undertake attachment as specified in the curriculum.
- Money for books and food are estimates for students' use and is therefore not paid to the university.
- Foreign students (Non East-African) to pay 20% more of the tuition fees.

\*This fee structure is subject to revision at the sole discretion of the University.
